

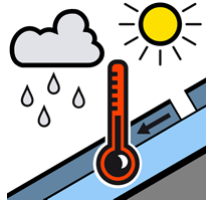

Avalanche Problems



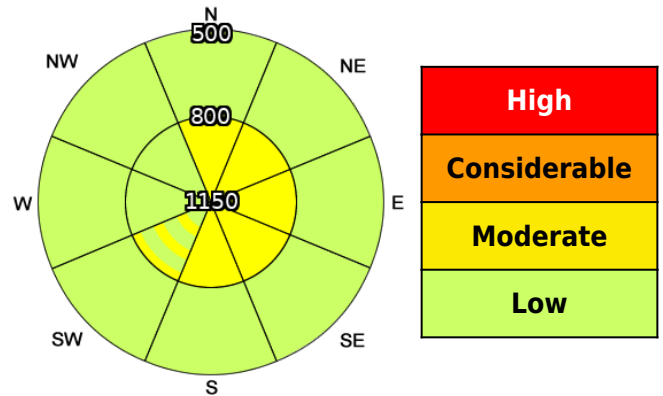
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will slowly consolidate in the settled conditions. Areas of unstable windslab will be present on North to East aspects above 800 metres. These areas will not be extensive, coire rims and gully tops being most affected. Also some minor wet snow instabilities are possible on South-East to South aspects above this level due to the strong solar warming. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain dry and settled with light to moderate South-Easterly winds. There will be some sunshine through the day. The freezing level will not be well defined with significant solar warming on Southerly aspects.
