

Avalanche Hazard Forecast - FOR PERIOD 18:00HRS Mon 30/03/2015 TO 18:00HRS Tue 31/03/2015



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong Westerly winds and snow showers. The freezing level will be around 1000m overnight, falling to 200m during the day.

Forecast Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard

Areas of unstable windslab will be present, mainly on steep North-East, East and South-East aspects above 900m. Localised accumulations will also be present in other sheltered locations. Avalanches are likely in these locations. Fresh cornices will be fragile and prone to collapse. Wind scoured snow slopes will be frozen and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable

Observed Weather Influences

Strong Westerly winds and snow showers above 500m.

Observed Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard

Large areas of unstable windslab have developed in sheltered locations. Greatest accumulations are on steep North-East, East and South-East aspects above 900m. Localised areas of unstable snow are also present in other locations. The avalanche hazard is Considerable
