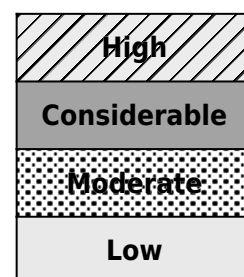
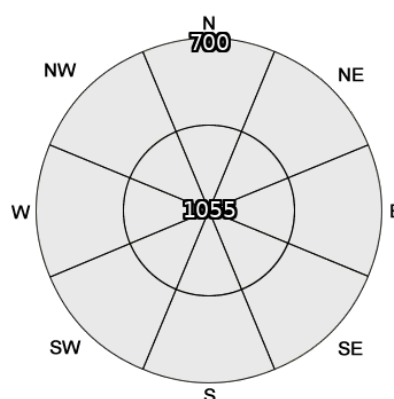


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 27/01/2022****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

There will be a general dusting of new snow above 700 metres, with most snow accumulating in sheltered North-East to South-East aspects, although not in significant amounts. The sparse and patchy old snow will refreeze and will be well bonded, firm and stable throughout. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will be a day of wintry showers with snow lying mostly on bare ground, generally above 700 metres. The Westerly gales will gradually moderate throughout the period. The freezing level will dip to 700 metres by daybreak rising to 800 metres through the day.

Comments

It will look and feel wintry on the summits tomorrow with a high windchill despite easing winds.
