



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The older patchy snow will refreeze becoming very firm and well bonded throughout. A dusting of new snow will be inconsequential. Greatest amounts of snow will be found in higher sheltered North to East facing corries. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, after some light rain at all levels, the freezing level will drop to around 800 metres with light snow showers in the morning. Gale force winds from the West-North-West throughout the day.

Comments

Remaining snow will become very firm and icy. Currently with short run outs, slips and trips will be potentially serious,
