



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 28/01/2022

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some wet snow instabilities will exist in any recent deposits. Old isolated patches will remain on North through East to South-East aspects, above 900 metres; these will be well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

The Freezing level will stay around 800 metres overnight, before rising to well above summits. There will be rain at all levels during the day. The winds will be moderate South Westerly, increasing West-South-Westerly by end of the period.

Comments

Some rock and ice fall potential in crag areas, with the onset of thaw at all levels and rain.
