
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Stability in the existing patchy snowpack will remain good with the surface becoming firm as the temperature drops. Isolated accumulations of unstable windslab will develop during the day, mainly on North-East to South-East aspects above 900 metres, but these are not expected to be deep or significant. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Rain overnight, this will turn to snow above around 500 metres during the day. Very strong South-West winds will veer West-North-Westerly and ease slightly through the day. The freezing level will drop from above the summits to around 600 metres.

Comments

Snowpack patchy with best cover on high North to East aspects.
