### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 30/01/2022


#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

During the afternoon isolated, shallow accumulations of unstable windslab will begin to develop on North-West to North-East aspects above 800 metres. Areas most affected will be in steep wind sheltered locations such as at the tops of gullies and beneath corrie rims. The old snowpack will remain well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

A dry night with strong North-Westerly winds easing moderate to light. Snowfall is expected through the afternoon on Southerly winds which will steadily increase strong to gale force. The 600 metre freezing level will rise later in the day to 900 metres.

#### Comments

Storm Corrie arriving on Sunday with outbreaks of snow and increasing winds through the afternoon.
