

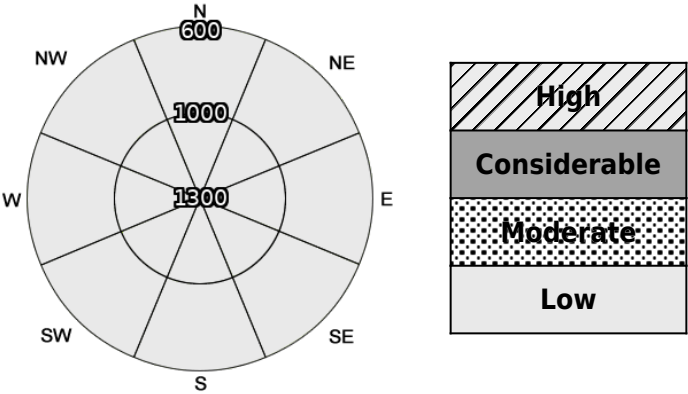

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 02/02/2022

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The limited snowpack will be well bonded and stable at all altitudes. The most widespread patches will remain on North-West through North to Easterly aspects above 1000 metres especially on steep coire back walls, ridge flanks and plateau areas. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Gale force Westerly winds will ease a little during the night and morning, before increasing through the afternoon. Dry conditions with hill fog up until late afternoon when there will be some light rain at all levels. Overnight the 900 metre freezing level will rise to, and remain above the summits.

Comments

Another mild day expected during Wednesday before it turns cold again on Thursday afternoon.
