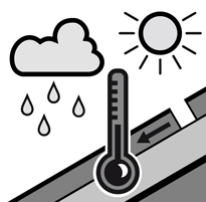

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 02/02/2022

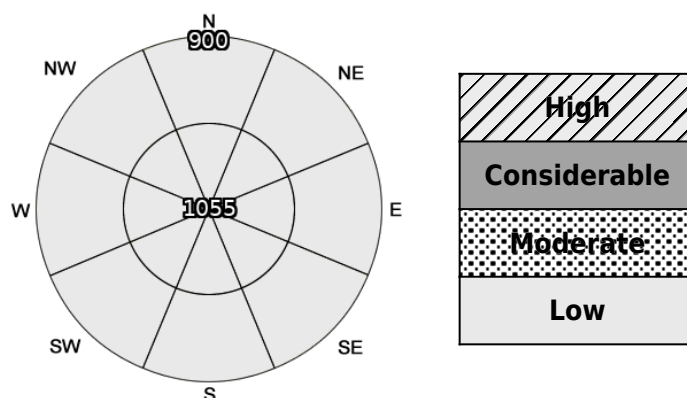
Avalanche Problems



Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw as the freezing level rises above the summits. Some minor wet snow instabilities will linger where the snow has gained any depth for example, ridge flanks and the tops of gullies. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be intermittent rain and light snow showers overnight, before turning to heavier rain for the rest of the period. The strong West-North-West winds will ease overnight becoming fresh to strong West-South-Westerly later. The freezing level will gradually rise from 800 metres to above the summits.
