



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 02/02/2022

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Remaining snow will initially be very firm and icy, softening slightly by the end of the afternoon but remaining well bonded throughout. Greatest amounts will be in higher North to East facing corries above 900 metres, mostly bare ground otherwise. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, the freezing level will drop to around 800 metres but will rise above the summits during the day. Light rain is expected in the afternoon. Winds initially West-North-West then backing to become West-South-West, strong throughout.

Comments

Wind strength forecast slightly less than of late. Old snow will be very firm with short run outs.
