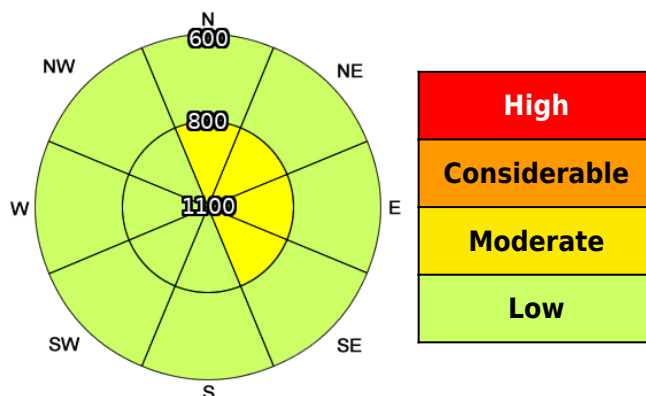

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of unstable windslab are expected to accumulate on North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres throughout the forecast period. Areas particularly affected will be steep corrie headwalls, gully exits and other wind sheltered locations. Fragile cornices will also build on these aspects. Wind exposed slopes will be mostly scoured. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong to Gale Force Westerly winds are expected bringing frequent snow showers. The freezing level will drop from around 600 metres to 300 metres by late evening.
