
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh windslab will accumulate during the period on North-East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. Accumulations will be found mainly in steep wind sheltered locations and will contain instabilities where they achieve depth. A light dusting of snow elsewhere will be shallow and inconsequential. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light snow showers are expected from glen level upwards as the freezing level lowers. Winds will be strong Westerly veering to West-North-West later. The freezing level will gradually drop from summit level to around 200 metres overnight.

Comments

Old snow firmer tomorrow as the freezing level lowers.
