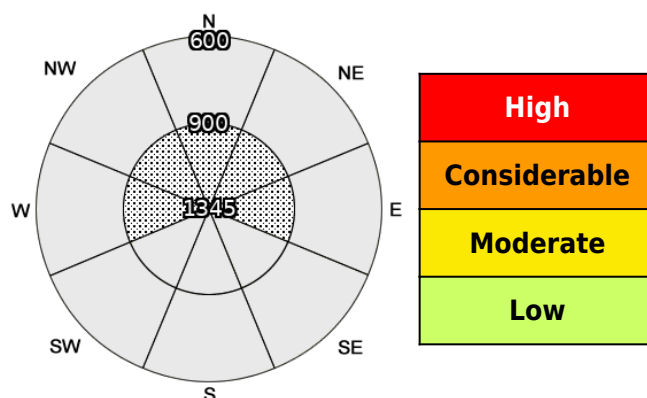


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 06/02/2022****Avalanche Problems****Wind Slab****Cornices****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Poorly bonded windslab will continue to accumulate throughout the forecast period on mainly North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres. Steep wind sheltered locations such as coire rims, gully tops and ridge flanks will be particularly affected, where deepening drifts will contain instabilities. New cornices will be fragile and prone to collapse. Outwith these locations new snow will lie on bare ground; wind exposed slopes will be icy. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

The freezing level will be around 300 metres. Snow is expected above 200 metres for the duration of the forecast period. Winds will be gale force and mainly from the West, veering West-North-Westerly in the afternoon.
