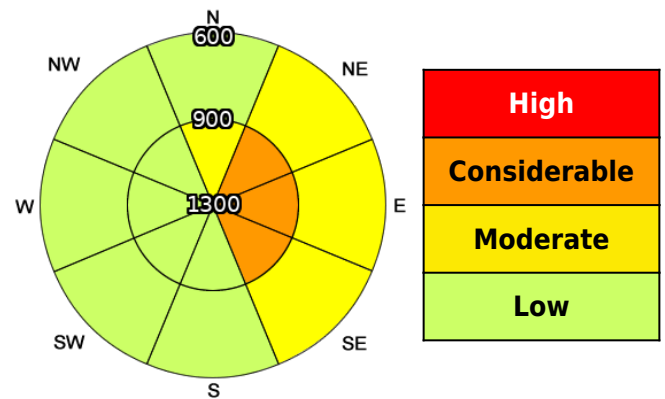
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Through the period windslab will continue to be deposited on North-East to South-East aspects above 900 metres with some cross-loading affecting North aspects. Although these areas of windslab will not be particularly extensive, they are expected to be poorly bonded. Below this altitude localised shallow accumulations will form. On other aspects the snowpack will tend to be very shallow. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers will continue overnight and through the day. Strong Westerly winds. The freezing level will be around 400 metres.
