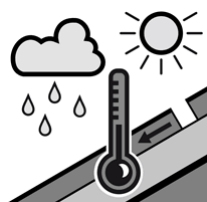

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 07/02/2022

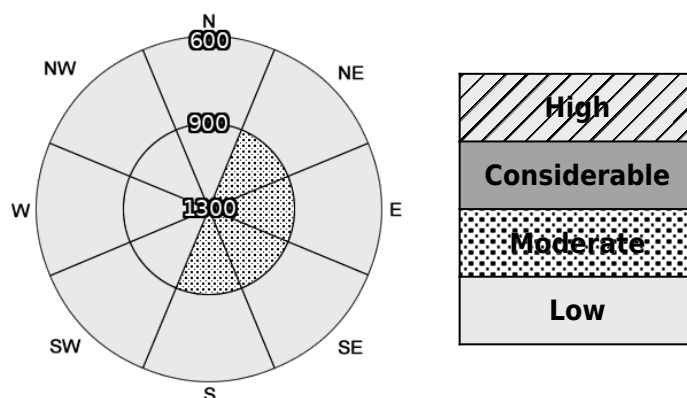
Avalanche Problems



Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will become wet in the mild conditions. Instability will remain in the recently deposited areas of windslab which will be found mainly on North-East through East to South aspects above 900 metres. These areas will tend not to be particularly extensive. Windward aspects will hold very little snow. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

After a cold and generally dry night the freezing level will rise well above the summits during the morning and remain there through the rest of the day. There will be some light rain during the afternoon. Strong winds will be from the South-West.

Comments

Milder on Monday but turning colder after that. Remaining windy.
