
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The surface layer of the older snowpack will refreeze but instabilities will persist in deep accumulations. New accumulations of poorly bonded windslab will develop mainly on North to East aspects above 900 metres. Greatest instabilities will continue to exist in steep wind sheltered locations such as coire rims, gully tops and ridge flanks. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight the freezing level will lower to around 500 metres. Light snow showers throughout the period with strong West-South-Westerly winds.
