

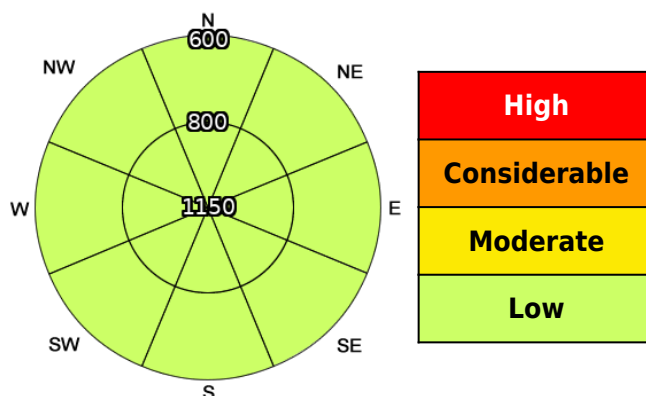
## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 08/02/2022

#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to consolidate and will become well bonded in all locations. Surface layers will become firmer as the colder conditions return. Deepest accumulations will be encountered above 800 metres on North through East to South aspects in wind sheltered locations such as gully tops, corrie rims and burn lines. Elsewhere terrain will be mostly wind scoured and bare. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight rain will ease to leave a mainly dry day. Initially the freezing level will be above the summits and will then drop to around 700 metres by morning. Gale force Westerly winds.

#### Comments

Following overnight rain, paths will become icy as colder conditions return.
