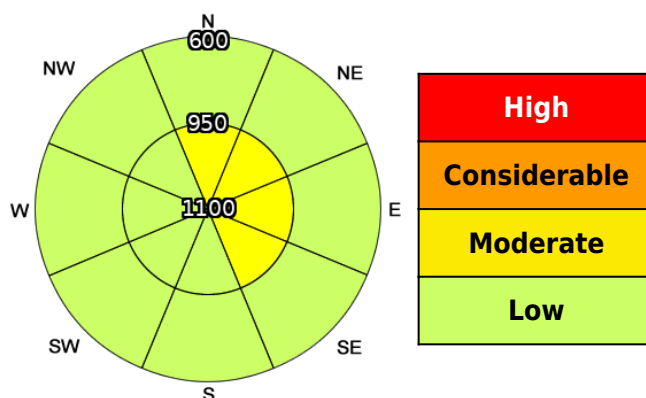

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

A period of poor stability and cornice collapse on steep North through East to South-East aspects above 900m on Monday evening. Better consolidated snow soon after in all locations and altitudes with the onset of colder conditions. New moderately bonded windslab development expected during Tuesday on North through East to South-East aspects above 950 metres. New accumulations are expected to be limited to gully tops and coire rims. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Mild with some rain before midnight then suddenly much cooler with snow showers for the remainder of the period. A strong West-South-Westerly airflow throughout.

Comments

Poor stability with cornice collapse Monday evening then a transition to better consolidated snow on Tuesday. Some new windslab on N to SE aspects later.
