

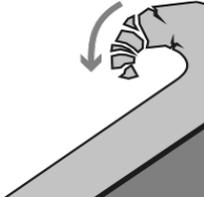


Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New accumulations of moderately bonded windslab will form mainly on North to East aspects above 850 metres. Other aspects may also be affected due to cross loading. New cornices will develop above similar aspects. Greatest instabilities will be in steep wind sheltered locations particularly coire rims, gully tops and ridge flanks. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will steadily lower to around 400 metres. Snow showers throughout this period falling to lower levels, accompanied by very strong West-South-Westerly winds.
