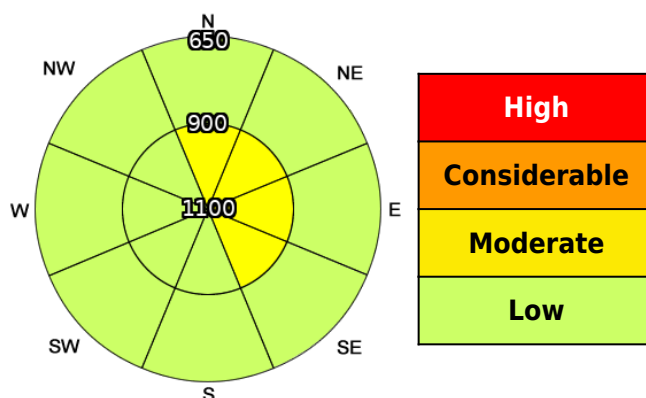

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Dry weak windslab will become more widespread on steep North through East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. Much better stability on less steep ground at lower altitudes where there will be a widespread crust. Good stability on all ridges and wind exposed locations. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Becoming noticeably colder. Regular showers of hail, graupel and snow. Strong West-South-West airflow throughout.

Comments

Hit or miss nature of forecasted shower activity may mean we may get more or less snow than forecast. Recalibrate hazard category accordingly.
