



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 13/02/2022

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

After some surface instabilities overnight the remaining snowpack will become generally well bonded. Greatest amounts of snow will remain on North through East to South-East aspects above 950 metres. At lower elevations, the patchy snow cover will continue to diminish. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight gale force South-Westerly winds will back, become North-Easterly and ease to light by mid morning. Snow showers, falling as rain below 900 metres will clear by dawn. The 900 metre freezing level will rise to 1000 metres through the day.
