

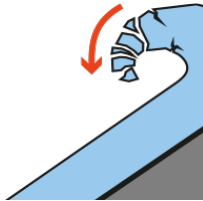

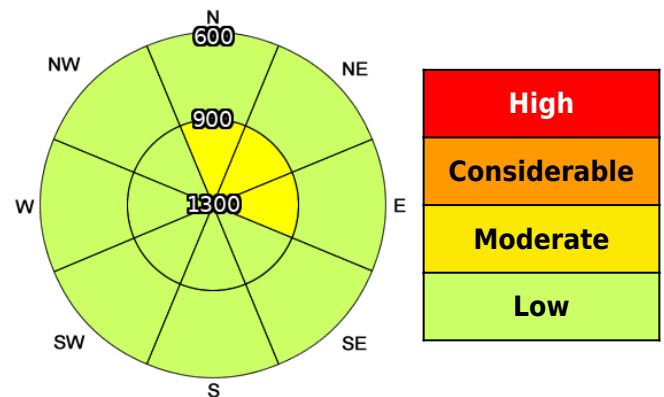
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised accumulations of unstable windslab will continue to develop on Northerly to Easterly aspects above 900 metres. Areas most affected will be around the tops of gullies and below coire rims. Apart from some isolated instabilities in areas of very steep terrain the old snowpack will become generally well bonded and stable at all altitudes. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Gale force South-Westerly winds overnight, easing through the day to become light to moderate, Southerly, then Northerly in direction. Snow showers will clear to leave a dry day. The 900 metre freezing level will rise to 1000 metres.

Comments

Winds expected to gradually ease through the morning.
