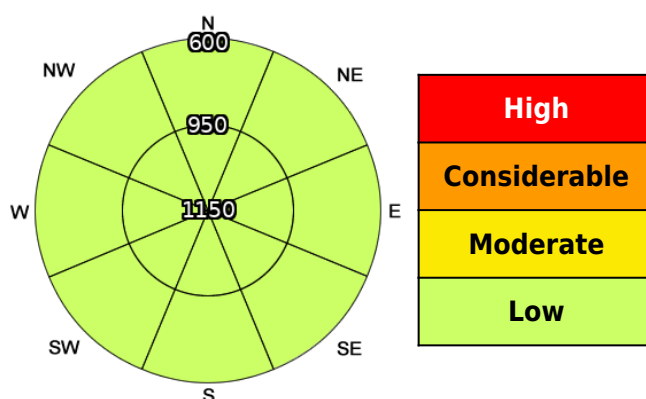


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 14/02/2022****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The snowpack will continue to consolidate and become firmer in the colder temperatures. Stability will be generally good. Localised deposits of generally shallow, moderately bonded new snow that exist mainly on North to East aspects above 950 metres, will gradually consolidate. These deposits will remain in sheltered locations such as gully tops and coire rims. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

A mainly dry cloudy day with only occasional light showers. The freezing level will be around 850 metres overnight, gradually lowering to around 500 metres by the end of the afternoon. Winds will be moderate North-Westerly.

Remaining colder with some snow on Tuesday before another warmer spell on Wednesday.
