
#### Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab




Wet Snow

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The moist snowpack will refreeze and become stable. Accumulations of new windslab expected on South-East to South aspects above 950 metres by the end of the day but not expected to be extensive or gain significant depth. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Progressively stronger NNE, later NNW, airflow. A few overnight snow showers then a dry interlude with more snow showers commencing before dawn. Becoming colder.
