



#### Avalanche Problems




Wind Slab

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The patchy snow will remain firm and icy in the lowering freezing levels. Shallow and inconsequential accumulations of wind slab will form in very wind sheltered locations on North-East through South-East to South-West aspects above 900 metres. Greatest amounts of snow will be found in higher North to East facing corries. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will be around 800 metres overnight but dropping to the glens during the day. Snow showers are expected throughout this forecasted period. Gale force winds from the North-North-West or North.

#### Comments

Wintry conditions expected on the hills.
