

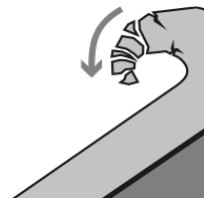

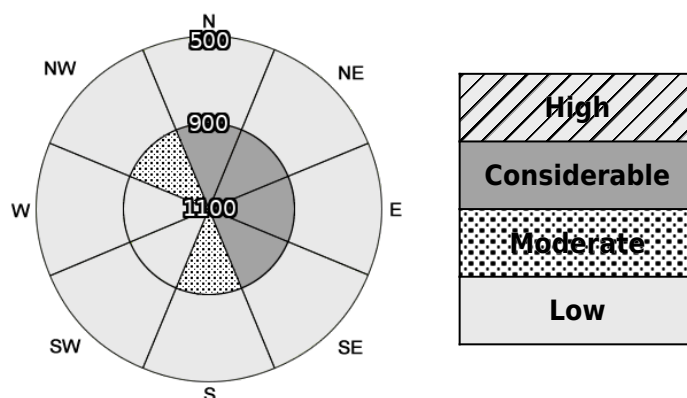
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New weak windslab is expected to become deeper and more widespread on steep North through East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. New weak cornice development anticipated over steepest lee slopes. The snowpack at lower altitudes and in most other locations is expected to become progressively better consolidated. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate generally Westerly airflow overnight becoming strong before dawn. Significantly colder throughout. Frequent snow showers, occasionally heavy, throughout the period.
