
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh areas of poorly bonded windslab will be deposited above 900 metres in locations sheltered from the strong winds. North-East to South-East aspects will be most affected. In locations exposed to the strong winds the snowpack will be shallow and generally stable. Fresh windslab will also accumulate below 900 meters, but stability will be better. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight snow showers are expected to ease through the day. Strong winds will be from the West. The freezing level will be around 500 metres.
