




Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Many wind exposed slopes will remain scoured and icy in places. Unstable windslab will be present in wind sheltered areas such as summit gullies and on slopes with a mainly North through East to South Easterly aspect above 850 metres, unstable cornices will exist above some of these locations. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light snow showers will affect the area overnight and on Friday. Variable winds will decrease to fresh becoming mainly North-Westerly through the day. The freezing level will be around 400 metres.
