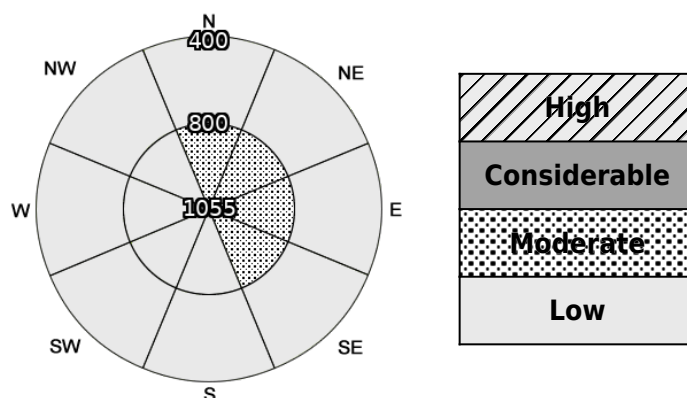


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 21/02/2022****Avalanche Problems****Wind Slab****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The existing moist snowpack will continue to consolidate and refreeze forming a surface crust. Fresh accumulations of windslab will begin to accumulate during the night on North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres. These accumulations are not expected to be large in extent and localised around corrie rims and the tops of gullies. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

After a cold start to the night the freezing level will rise to around 800 metres by midnight and remain at that level for the forecast period. Overnight snow on strong South-Westerly winds will moderate by daybreak as the winds veer to the North-West and decrease in strength.
