



Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Existing windslab instabilities will consolidate in most places, before new areas of moderately bonded windslab again form in wind sheltered locations. Sheltered locations such as gullies, scarp slopes and steep coire rims and on slopes with a North through East to South-Easterly aspect above 850 metres will be mostly affected. Cornices will be unstable above similar aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will briefly rise above the summits in the early hours of Tuesday morning with rain. Then, freezing level will fall to around 600 metres with snow showers and strong to gale force Westerly winds.
