



##### Avalanche Problems




Wind Slab

##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab mainly on North through East to South-East aspects above 750 meters. Areas of most concern will be wind sheltered areas such as coire rims, gully exits and below ridge crests. New fragile cornices above these locations. Other aspects will be affected by cross-loading. Wind exposed locations will be stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



##### Forecast Weather Influences

Gale force winds will be mainly South-Westerly overnight veering West-South-West during the day. The freezing level will rise from 500 meters to around 900 meters before falling during the daylight hours to 400 meters. Snowfall is expected throughout the period with the heaviest being during the morning.

##### Comments

Stormy and serious conditions expected on the hill.
