

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will become widespread on Northerly to Easterly aspects above 900 metres where avalanches are likely. Areas mostly affected will be where deep accumulations develop within steep terrain. Fragile cornices will overhang these areas. Unstable windslab on the same aspects below 900 metres, terrain features such as steep banks and shallow gullies will be affected. Cross loading will affect North-West and South-East aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snowfall will continue at all levels overnight, rising to above 200 metres during the day. Strong winds will be from the South-West or West-South-West. The freezing level will fluctuate between 300 and 500 metres.

Comments

Much cooler temperatures expected over the next 24 hours with further snowfall.
