




Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will continue to develop on North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres. The greatest accumulations will develop in wind sheltered areas and features such as coire rims, gully tops and below ridge crests. Fragile cornices will build on these aspects. Other areas will be affected by cross-loading. Shallower accumulations of moderately bonded windslab will develop below 800 meters. Wind exposed locations will be stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Gale force winds from a mainly South-West to West South-West direction. Snowfall at all levels throughout the forecast period with the heaviest during the day. The freezing level will be around 300 meters.

Another day of blizzards expected and a drop in temperature.
