




Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Extensive unstable windslab will be present in wind-sheltered areas, with greatest accumulations on North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres. Fragile cornice will exist above these aspects. More localised windslab will also be present on other aspects and at lower altitudes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight winds will be Westerly or West-North-Westerly, strong at first then gradually easing to be light during the morning. During the day winds will back South-South-Westerly and strengthen again. Snowfall is expected overnight at all levels, then a dry day. During the day the freezing level will rise from 400 metres to around 700 metres.

Comments

The wintry conditions will continue.
