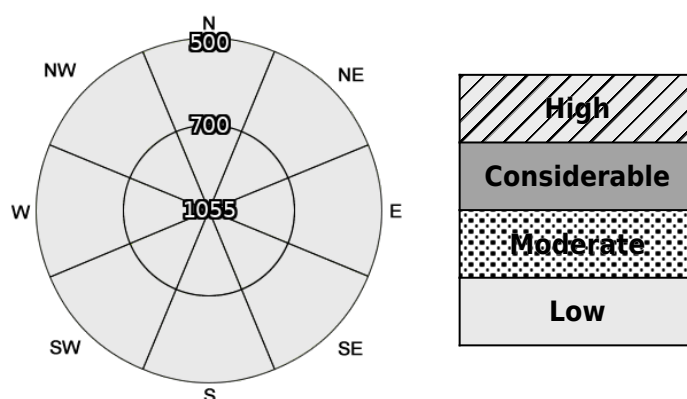


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 27/02/2022****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The snowpack will generally have good stability throughout. Accumulations of fresh snow will develop above 850 meters on steep North-West to North-East aspects. However, these deposits are expected to be isolated and easily avoidable. There will be a thaw at lower elevations. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Gale to storm force Southerly winds overnight will moderate during the morning and then strengthen to gale force by the evening. There will be small amounts of snow above 850 meters during the morning. The freezing level will be above the summits initially, then lower to 850 meters before rising slowly to above the summits by the end of the forecast period.
