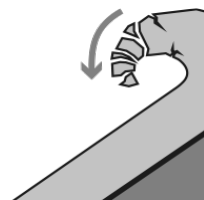
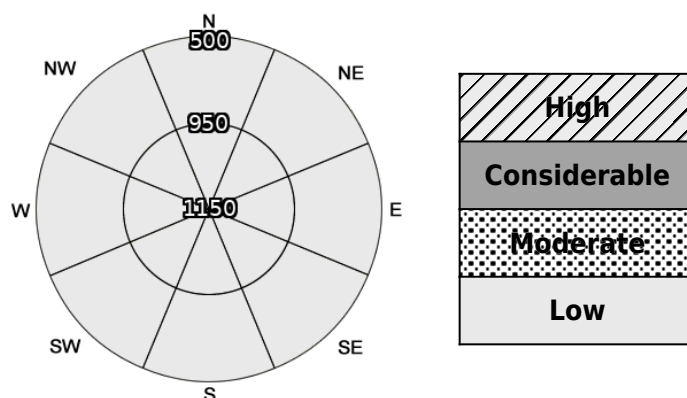


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 01/03/2022****Avalanche Problems****Cornices****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Snowpack stability will generally remain good. Above 900 metres the surface will be firm and icy in exposed areas. Below 900 metres it will be progressively softer and moist. Shallow surface instabilities may exist on the steepest slopes and gullies mainly with a North to Easterly aspect. Remaining cornices will be fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

A trace of new snow is expected overnight then dry conditions will affect the area on Tuesday. The freezing level will be around 800 to 900 metres. Winds will be light to moderate generally from a South-Westerly direction.

Comments

A much calmer outlook than of late. Corniced areas require caution.
