





Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Snowpack stability for much of the period will remain good, but light snow later in the day followed by light rain at all levels will form surface wet snow instabilities in sheltered gullies and on North-West through North to North-Easterly aspects. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain dry overnight and for much of Wednesday. A brief period of snow mid afternoon will affect slopes mainly above 950 metres before turning to rain at all levels. Precipitation levels are not expected to be great. Winds will be East-South-Easterly fresh becoming strong through the day.

Comments

Precipitation amounts of snow and rain are expected to be light, should this increase alter the avalanche hazard accordingly. Cornices will be prone to collapse.
