

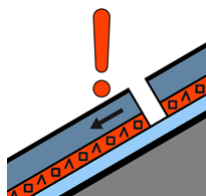

Avalanche Problems



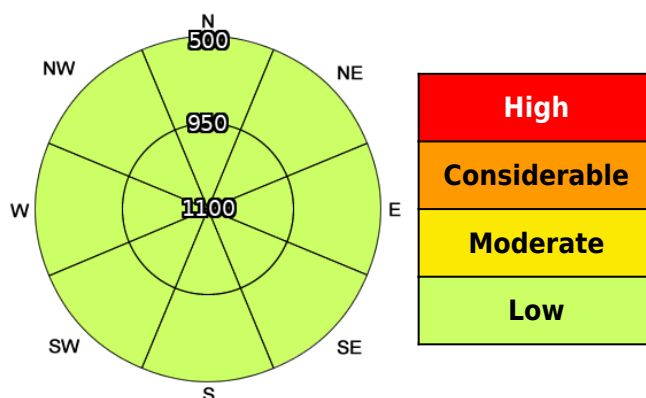
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Good stability in most locations. Thin accumulations of weaker windslab confined to steep and sheltered North-West to North-East aspects above 950 metres, mainly gully tops and coire rims. Selected East aspects will also be affected by the end of the day. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong South East airflow easing. Less cold but freezing level remaining below summits. Light precipitation from late morning falling as snow at higher altitudes.
