



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 05/03/2022

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected to the snowpack. It will remain firm and well bonded in all locations. Surface layers will be frozen and icy which could lead to serious consequences on steep ground in the event of a slip. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, another frost in the glens, freezing level will be around 500 metres. A dry, clear day with sunny spells with the freezing level rising to around 800 metres. Moderate Westerly winds veering, becoming Northerly and easing through the day.

Comments

Vergas or ice can be expected on approach paths and on rocks.
