



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 06/03/2022

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected to the snowpack. It will remain firm and well bonded in all locations. Surface layers will be frozen and often icy which could lead to serious consequences on steep ground in the event of a slip. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, another frost in the glens, the freezing level will be around 800 metres. A dry, clear day with plenty of sunshine. The summit temperature will rise to around minus 2 Celsius during the afternoon. Light South-Easterly winds veering, becoming more Southerly and strengthening slightly.

Comments

Snowpack is frozen, firm and icy.
