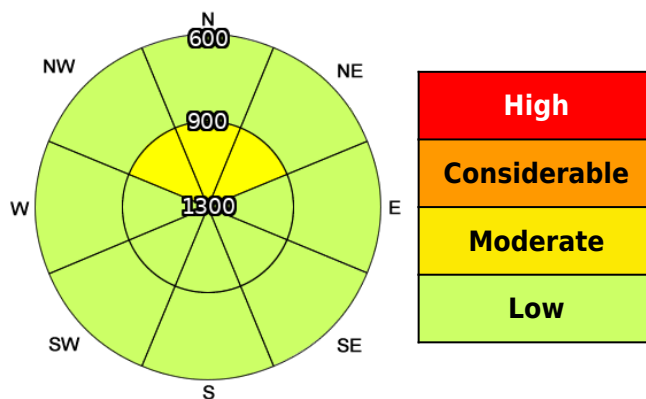


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 08/03/2022****Avalanche Problems****Wind Slab****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Areas of unstable windslab will remain above 900 metres in locations sheltered from the strong winds. Most affected will be North-West to North-East aspects. These areas of slab will not be extensive, and should be generally avoidable. In more exposed locations, particularly on windward aspects, the snowpack will scoured, icy and stable. Below 900 meters the snowpack will be generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will be a dry day with gale force winds from the South-South-East. The freezing level will be around 600 metres.

Although much of the hill will be scoured, areas of windslab will remain.
