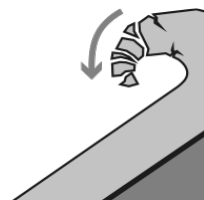

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 08/03/2022

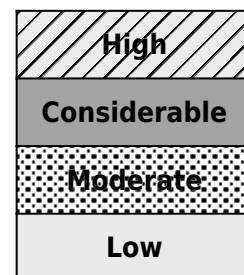
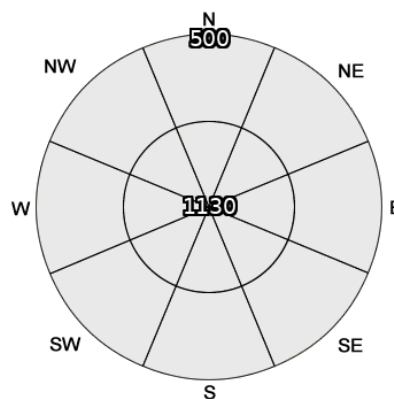
Avalanche Problems



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will be generally firm and well bonded. Aspects sheltered from the wind and exposed to the sun will begin to soften. Cornices present mainly on East aspects will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight it will be generally clear and cold at most levels, with increasing fresh to strong South-East winds. Remaining dry and windy through the day. The freezing level will rise to around 800 metres.

Comments

Fresh snow on the summits is expected during the early evening, into the next forecast period.
