

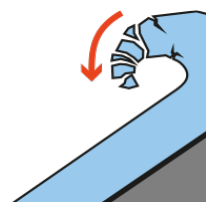

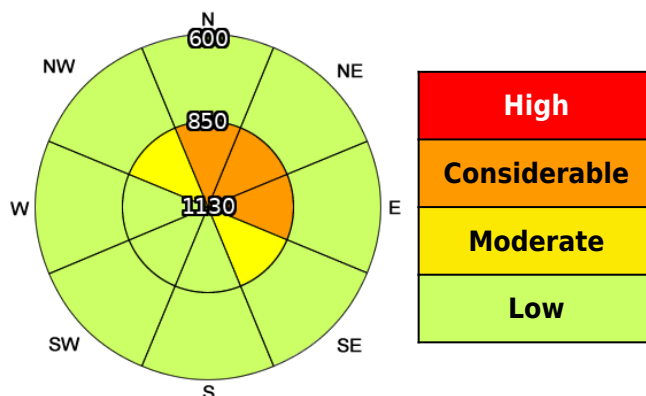
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will initially be deposited in wind sheltered areas. Greatest accumulations will be on North through East to South-East aspects above 850 metres. Some wet snow instabilities will then develop in these areas with the onset of rain to all levels. Any recent cornice build up will be liable to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Cooler conditions overnight with the Freezing Level lowering to around 500 metres, accompanied by further snow showers. The Freezing Level will then rise once again to above summits with further precipitation, bringing rain and drizzle to all, levels from first light. A strong South- Easterly, then Southerly air flow will affect the area.
