




Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

During the night wet snow instabilities will slowly consolidate. Fresh unstable windslab will form in steep wind sheltered locations mainly on North-West to North-East aspects above 1000 metres. Greatest accumulations will be around coire rims and gully tops. Isolated windslab may also form on West and East aspects due to cross loading. Cornices will build on these aspects also. At lower elevations the snowpack will be generally moist and well bonded. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Gale force Southerly winds will ease slightly overnight, becoming moderate or fresh through the day. Precipitation throughout the period will initially fall as snow around the highest summits. During the day there will be snow to lower elevations. Overnight the freezing level will fall from above the summits and remain at 1000 metres.
