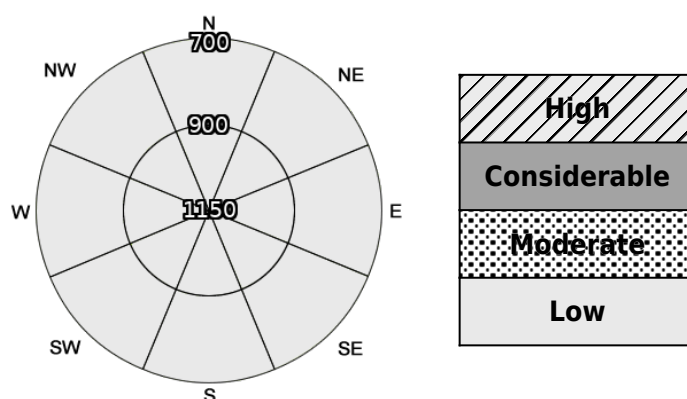


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 13/03/2022****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Above 1050 metres the snowpack will consolidate in the cooler conditions. Below this level it will continue to slowly thaw. Stability will be generally good throughout. There will be a shallow covering of fresh snow above 900 metres. Although some minor surface instabilities will exist, these accumulations will in general be very shallow. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

A period of light precipitation overnight will be followed by some light showers through the day. In both cases this will fall as snow above 900 metres. The freezing level will be around 1000 metres overnight rising to 1100 metres during the day. Winds will be from the South-East.
