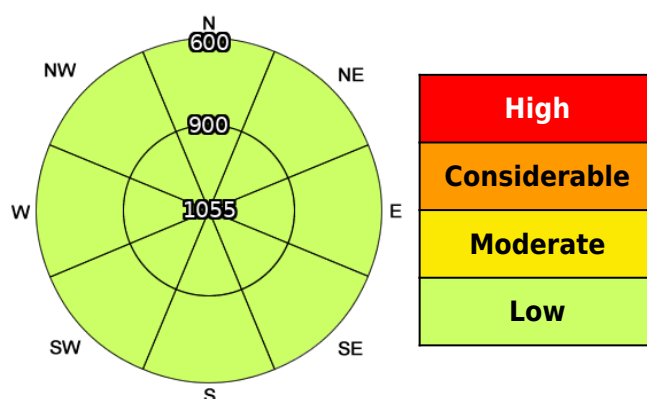


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 13/03/2022****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The snowpack will remain generally well bonded and stable throughout. Fresh windslab, most likely to be found on West to North aspects above 900 metres, is expected to be very isolated and shallow. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Strong South-Easterly winds and occasional showers falling as snow only on the highest summits. The freezing level will rise from around 900 metres to 1200 metres through the period.

Comments

Most snow remains on North, through East to South-East aspects above 700 metres.
