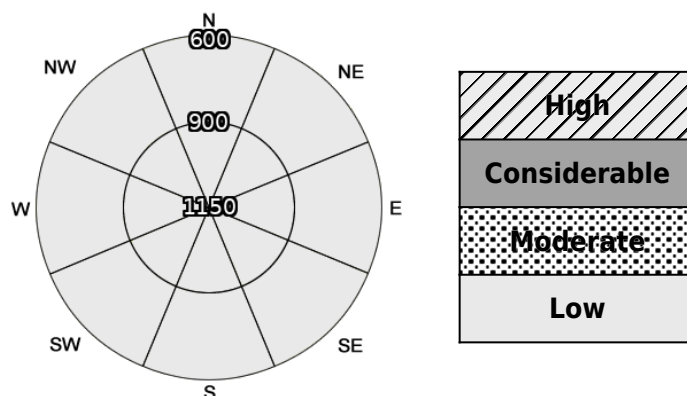


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 15/03/2022****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The snow will refreeze, become firmer and will remain well bonded throughout. Any new snow will be inconsequential. Most aspects will hold snow above 1000 metres with snow restricted to sheltered features at lower levels. Exposed ridges will be bare. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

The freezing level will be around 1000 metres at the start and end of this forecasted period but it will briefly drop to 600 metres around dawn. Very little new snowfall is expected. Winds will strengthen, mostly from the South becoming gale force by the afternoon.

Comments

The soft snow is expected to become firmer, potentially icy around the higher summits.
