
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will gradually consolidate through the day. However, instabilities will remain in recent windslab accumulations, mainly in gullies and on steep slopes with a North to East aspect above 1000 metres. Elsewhere the snowpack will be generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

A mainly dry day with some sunshine. The freezing level will be around 600 metres overnight rising above all summits during the day. Moderate South-Westerly winds overnight will back, to become Southerly by morning and strengthen slightly during the day.
