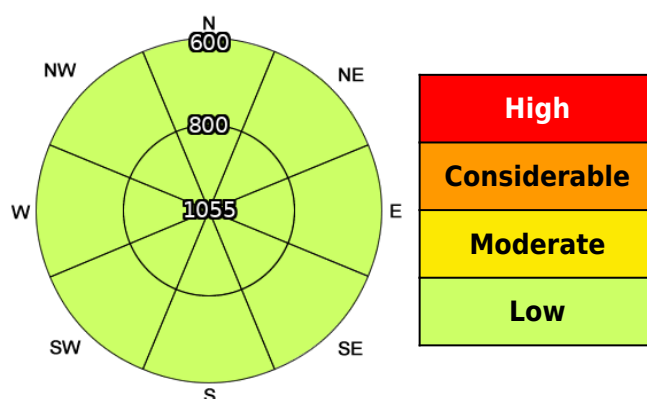


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 19/03/2022****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The isolated and mainly avoidable accumulations of windslab on North to East aspects above 800 metres will continue to consolidate. The older snowpack will remain generally well bonded and stable throughout. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Southerly winds will back to the South-South-East and remain strong. The freezing level will remain above the highest summits for the forecast period and no precipitation is expected.

Comments

High pressure remains dominant. Dry and sunny with strong to gale force winds - sun cream advisable.
