

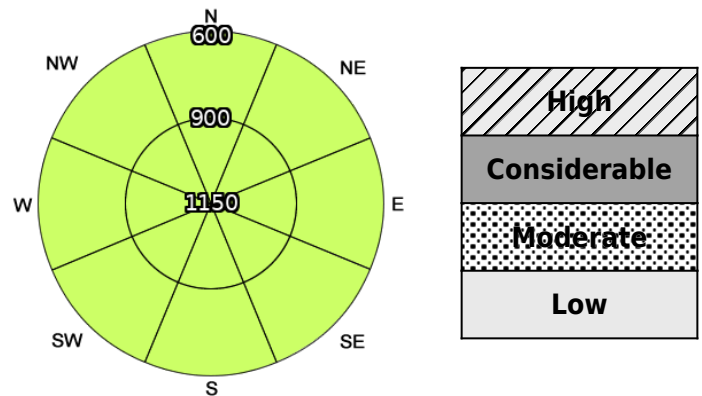

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 20/03/2022

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The remaining snow will be generally well bonded and stable. Isolated pockets of less well bonded windslab will be encountered in steeper, wind sheltered locations such as gully tops and around corrie rims on North to East aspects above 1000 metres. These accumulations will be shallow and mostly avoidable. Good cover above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

No precipitation. Strong South-South-Easterly winds. Freezing level lowering overnight to settle around 900 metres.

Comments

Old snow firm and often icy in the shade. Dry weather set to continue after the weekend.
